



Dodgeland Athletic Department

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This letter serves as the reminder that all Dodgeland athletes must have current physical information on file with the Athletic Director's office prior to beginning any athletic practices. The WIAA physical forms and alternate-year cards are available on the district website, in the middle/high school office as well as the district office. **At the bottom of the enclosed Beaver Dam Orthopedics & Sports Medicine flyer, your child's current athletic physical information has been identified.** If the last physical occurred before April 1, 2017, a new physical is necessary and a WIAA Athletic Permit Form completed by the physician and parent. If the last physical was on or after April 1, 2017, a WIAA Alternate Year form with parental signature is necessary.

Beaver Dam Orthopedics & Sports Medicine is accepting appointments for athletic physicals that will be conducted at Dodgeland on July 26th (1:00 – 5:00 pm) and August 2nd (1:00 – 5:00 pm). The cost for these physicals is \$35.00 each. Beaver Dam Orthopedics & Sports Medicine will once again donate \$25 from every physical to the Dodgeland Athletic Department. **Call 920-219-4009 to schedule a physical now.** Medical appointments fill up quickly and athletes are not allowed to participate in any practices without a current physical or alternate-year card on file. Every athlete will also receive a free t-shirt at the conclusion of their sports physical conducted at Dodgeland!

It is also the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide the Athletic Director's Office with current insurance information. Each athlete must have accident/health insurance coverage in order to be a participant. This information must be completed on the physical form and alternate year card. The Dodgeland School District does not carry student medical/hospitalization insurance for any of its students. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to financially provide proper medical coverage.

2018-2019 Mandatory Sports Meeting - July 30, 2018 7:00 PM

The Dodgeland School District will be providing ONE sports meeting for all parents and athletes in grades 5-12. This meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 30th beginning at 7:00 pm in the high school gym. The Wisconsin Concussion Law, Act 172, Statute 118.293 requires all parents/guardians and athletes to be educated on the risks of concussions and head injuries. Therefore, **any student planning on participating in any athletic activity during the 2018-2019 school year must attend this meeting with a parent or guardian.** Athletes and parents not in attendance at the July 30th meeting will be required to attend an alternative meeting date or watch a video copy of this entire meeting and complete an accompanying document consisting of questions of the meeting content and concussion information. **The student-athlete may not participate in any practices until this meeting obligation is fulfilled by both student and parent.**
